1. Q. What course must I be studying to be eligible to enter EYECOn 11?  
A. This competition is open to all tertiary students currently studying photography and assistant photographers within New Zealand.
  
2. Q. Do I have to shoot my portfolio of work on Canon gear?  
A. No you can compile your work with any gear; the EYECOn competition is about recognising the work and dedication of New Zealand's up and coming photographers and celebrating a passion for photography.
  
3. Q. I am not a tertiary student or apprentice photographer however I love taking photos can I still apply?  
A. Unfortunately you cannot enter; the EYECOn competition is specifically for tertiary photography students and apprentice photographers however we encourage your passion for photography.
  
4. Q. Can you please explain what an apprentice photographer is?  
A. An apprentice photographer is someone who is learning the art and trade of photography from a qualified photographer. This requires one or more years of on-the-job training through job experience along with related instruction, prior to working as a full-time, trained photographer.
  
5. Q. I go to a university / tertiary school am I eligible?  
A. If you are studying any tertiary level qualification where you undertake photographic study / papers or majors then you can enter.
