



Terms and Conditions:

The following terms and conditions govern the basis upon which Canon **EYECOn** 11 will be conducted. The signatory on the Registration Form agrees to be bound by all of the terms and conditions here under. The signed entry form confirms the entrant's consent to these Terms and Conditions.

1. This registration form must be completed in full. The completed registration form needs to be submitted to Canon New Zealand by September 1st 2011.
2. The competition is open to all tertiary students studying photography in 2011 and all assistant photographers.
3. Canon New Zealand, reserve the right to use the photographs and reproduce illustrations of selected works for publicity specifically relating to Canon **EYECOn** for a period of two years after the event. Any photo used in the publicity of Canon **EYECOn** that is not from the winning portfolios will be paid \$100NZ dollars in return for the use of the photo. The photographer will be noted against all photos used. Any other use will need to be agreed in writing with copyright holder.
4. The work submitted must be the original work of the person named on the registration form as described in the copyright Act of 1994. Any attempt at plagiarism will result in immediate disqualification.
5. Entrants must be the legal copyright owner of photographic works entered and copyright of the work remains with the holder.
6. The organisers acknowledge the moral rights provisions of the Copyright Act 1994, including the right to be identified as the author of the work and the right to object to derogatory treatment of the work. To preserve the artistic integrity of the entry, no work will be intentionally edited, altered, demeaned or misrepresented in any way. The authorship of the entrant will be clearly acknowledged in each case of use.
7. It is the entrant's responsibility to obtain appropriate written permission from people or owners of property that are identifiable in their work. The entrant must produce evidence of that consent, to the organisers, if requested.
8. The entrant fully indemnifies the organisers against any claims arising from the display or use of unaltered work as described herein and from the infringement of intellectual property rights of any third party.
9. The work will **not be returned to the registered entrant unless** entrants include suitable addressed packaging for the return of work. A courier ticket or postage to cover cost of delivery must be included with the entry form. If there is no suitable return address, packaging or courier ticket included, the work may be disposed of by the organizers 90 days after the winners are announced
10. All entries will be treated with care, but no responsibility will be accepted in the case of loss or damage. Insurance is the entrant's sole responsibility unless agreed in writing with the organiser.
11. Entries submitted without a signed entry form will not be accepted. Incomplete entries or entries that do not conform to the submission requirements will be deemed invalid.
12. The judge's decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into.
13. If awarded the title of **EYECOn** 11 winner must make themselves available for days spent with photographic mentors.
