Please be advised that when EF24mmf/2.8 IS USM and EF28mm f/2.8 IS USM are used with EOS-1D Mark IV, the firmware of the camera should be updated to version 1.1.1 or later. The firmware is to be released in March 2012. The update will help to optimise the exposure accuracy.
